CONSTITUTION

PREAMBLE: We, the founding members of the **Indian Association of Abacus and Mental Arithmetic (IAAMA)**, recognizing the importance of structured cognitive education, mental development, and numerical intelligence among children and youth of India, hereby adopt this Constitution to regulate and govern the affairs of the Association. IAAMA is established to standardize Abacus and Mental Arithmetic education through district-based associations and institutional affiliations across India, operating in academic partnership with the Indian Strategy Institute (ISI).

ARTICLE I – NAME, LEGAL STATUS & JURISDICTION

1. The name of the Association shall be **Indian Association of Abacus and Mental Arithmetic (IAAMA)**.
2. IAAMA shall function as a national-level educational association.
3. The Registered Office shall be situated in India as decided by the Governing Council.
4. The operational jurisdiction shall extend throughout India.
5. IAAMA shall function exclusively through:
 - District Association Membership
 - Institutional Membership

ARTICLE II – VISION, MISSION & CORE VALUES

2.1 Vision

To create a scientifically structured and globally recognized Abacus and Mental Arithmetic education system in India.

2.2 Mission

- To standardize curriculum and certification.
- To ensure district-level educational administration.
- To promote cognitive excellence among students.
- To maintain international academic alignment and accreditation.

2.3 Core Values

- Academic Integrity
 - Transparency
 - Quality Assurance
 - Inclusivity
 - Ethical Governance
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ARTICLE III – OBJECTIVES

1. To promote Abacus and Mental Arithmetic education nationwide.
 2. To develop structured curriculum aligned with ISI.
 3. To conduct examinations and issue certifications.
 4. To establish District Associations across India.
 5. To organize competitions, seminars, conferences, and teacher training.
 6. To maintain accreditation standards (ISO, IDSI, IRSPI aligned systems).
 7. To collaborate with universities and international bodies.
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ARTICLE IV – ACADEMIC PARTNERSHIP & ACCREDITATION

4.1 Academic Alignment

IAAMA curriculum shall be aligned with the academic framework of the Indian Strategy Institute.

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ARTICLE V – MEMBERSHIP STRUCTURE

5.1 Types of Membership

A. District Association Membership

1. Only one District Association per district.
2. Annual Membership Fee: **Rs. 5,000**
3. Renewal mandatory every financial year.
4. Rights:
 - Conduct IAAMA certification exams.
 - Use IAAMA authorized logo.
 - Participate in national conferences.
 - Voting rights in General Body.
5. Responsibilities:
 - Maintain minimum 5 institutional members.
 - Submit annual academic report.
 - Maintain student records.

B. Institutional Membership

1. Open to schools, academies, tuition centers, NGOs.
 2. Annual Membership Fee: **Rs. 3,000**
 3. Rights:
 - Offer IAAMA approved courses.
 - Register students for exams.
 - Receive certification materials.
 4. No voting rights unless designated as district office.
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ARTICLE VI – CERTIFICATION FRAMEWORK

IAAMA shall offer the following structured certification levels:

1. **Certification of Foundation Abacus**
2. **Certification of Intermediate Abacus**
3. **Certification of Advanced Abacus**
4. **Certification of Mental Arithmetic**
5. **Diploma in Abacus and Mental Arithmetic**
6. **Post Graduate Diploma in Abacus and Mental Arithmetic**

6.1 Examination System

- Centralized syllabus.
- Uniform assessment criteria.
- Practical and written components.
- Online and offline modes permitted.

6.2 Certification Authority

- Certificates jointly aligned with ISI curriculum.
 - Accreditation references may include ISO, IDSI, IRSPI standards.
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ARTICLE VII – GOVERNANCE STRUCTURE

7.1 National Governing Council

The Association shall be governed by:

- President
- Vice President

- Academic Director
- Five Executive Members

7.2 Duties

President

- Chief executive authority.
- Presides over meetings.

Zone Director

- Administrative head.

District Director

- Administrative head

- Manages accounts.
- Prepares annual financial statements.

Institution Incharge

- Ensures curriculum and course implementation.
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ARTICLE VIII – TERM OF OFFICE

1. Tenure: 3 Years.
 2. Maximum two consecutive terms.
 3. Removal by 2/3 majority for misconduct.
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ARTICLE IX – MEETINGS

1. Annual General Meeting – Once per year.
 2. Executive Committee Meeting – Quarterly.
 3. Special Meeting – On written request of 1/3 members.
 4. Quorum – 50% of eligible voting members.
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ARTICLE X – FINANCE & ACCOUNTS

10.1 Sources of Income

- Membership Fees
- Certification Fees
- Training Fees
- Events & Conferences
- Grants & Donations

10.2 Financial Management

- All transactions through bank account.
 - Joint signatory system.
 - Annual Audit mandatory.
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ARTICLE XI – CODE OF CONDUCT

Members shall:

- Maintain academic honesty.
- Avoid false claims.
- Protect brand reputation.
- Follow examination ethics.

Violation may result in:

- Warning
 - Suspension
 - Termination
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ARTICLE XII – AMENDMENT PROCEDURE

- Proposal in writing.
 - Circulation 30 days prior.
 - 2/3 majority approval required.
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ARTICLE XIII – DISPUTE RESOLUTION

- Internal mediation committee.
 - Appeal to Governing Council.
 - Jurisdiction: Registered Office location.
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ARTICLE XIV – DISSOLUTION

- Requires 3/4 majority.
 - Assets transferred to similar educational non-profit.
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ARTICLE XV – OFFICIAL SEAL

- IAAMA shall maintain official seal.
 - Logo misuse punishable.
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ARTICLE XVI – DECLARATION

This Constitution is adopted by the founding members of IAAMA to regulate its functioning, academic structure, governance, and membership framework.
